**Subject:** PCC Election Update – elections are postponed

#### Summary

If the PCC election is postponed, the Police and Crime Commissioner Kathryn Holloway would complete her duties remotely:

- Monthly Strategic Boards would be held by teleconference
- PCC would fully brief her Chief Executive Clare Kelly regarding BCH/7 Force matters and to ensure that PCC's decisions are fully understood - these meetings may also be held remotely or be cancelled.
- PCC and Chief Executive will ensure all office business is discussed by phone or in person depending on the public health situation at the time.
- Chief Executive/CC and DCC have 24/7 access to the PCC via telephone.
- PCC will be paid as usual until a new PCC is elected.
- The Bedfordshire Criminal Justice Board (BCJB) will be held remotely by teleconference if at all.
- PCC will not attend the CJB Exec Boards – Chief Executive should convey any decisions or information from the office regarding this.
- PCC will not attend APCC events, in the unlikely event that they are held.
- PCC will attend the National CT Strategic Collaboration Board if able to do so (as a national public duty).

Note - If the election is delayed more than 3 months – then PCC and Chief Executive will review the commissioning process and the 301k which has been left for new PCC and how it will be spent.
